OAK RIDGE JUNIOR INTERN ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

The **Junior Intern position at the Oak Ridge Youth Development School** site is a voluntary position with a small stipend for the total ORYDS's session. Junior Interns will also receive 80 community service hours. Junior Interns should be familiar with the culture and dynamics of the community, committed to the goals of the School's program, and able to work collaboratively with all program constituents.

Junior Interns will:

- Participate in scheduled local training. (3 weeks prior to opening of school)
- Responsible for decorating the Family Life Center with staff support.
- Assist Servant Leader Interns.
- Participate in daily Harambee time, Conflict Resolution, Science, Kids In The Kitchen, Swimming, Sports, and other daily academic/recreational activities.
- Assist and interact with scholars during breakfast, lunch, and outdoor free play and during after school care.
- Participate in staff debriefing sessions as requested;
- Work effectively as part of the Oak Ridge Youth Development School's volunteer staff;
- Assume other duties as assigned by the Project Director, or Site Coordinator.
- Have a positive learning experience.
- Comply with the Staff Conduct & Dress Code "Best Practices."
